National Drug Therapeutic Committee - Terms of Reference

Terms of Reference

The National Drug Therapeutic Committee is constituted by the Director General of Health Services to act on its behalf in respect of the following

1. Key objectives

- To manage the policies, guidelines, regulations related to the safe, effective and efficient use of medicines
- To improve the awareness of the quality and standards of managing the medical supplies
- To promote rational prescribing ,standard treatment guidelines and minimizing the medication errors
- To monitor and follow up the utilization of medical supplies

2. Terms of reference of the committee

- 1. To make recommendations on and formulate Policy, regulations regarding the safe, effective and cost-effective prescribing and use of medicines in the treatment of patients in the state sector.
- 2. To provide 'evidence based' advice on the safe and effective use of medicines, specially within the state sector
- 3. To review medicines usage in the state sector and make recommendations or publish guidance as appropriate.
- 4. To monitor and review prescribing practices within the state sector and provide appropriate guidance or feedback as necessary for Rational Use of Drugs.
- 5. To establish and constitute sub-committees in respect of specific actions required of the Committee.
- 6. To review clinical incident reports involving prescribing or administration of medicines and report to the DGHS as it considers necessary
- 7. To review and approve clinical or hospital policies involving the use and/or administration of medicines within the given hospital.
- 8. To make recommendations or approve policies relating to other pharmaceutical items available for use in the state sector including nutrition supplements, disinfectants, surgical dressings, medicinal diagnostic agents and kits.

- 9. To monitor and regulate the use of unlicensed medicines and licensed medicines used outside of the terms of their Product License.
- 10. To monitor highly priced medicines
- 11. To consider any matters appropriate to the Committee as may be referred to it.

6. Quorum/deputies

Five members of whom at least three should be Consultants and one a clinical pharmacologist and one Pharmacist. If members cannot attend a deputy or suitable representative will be acceptable.

7. Declarations of interest

All committee members are required to state in writing any interests they hold in the pharmaceutical industry, be they direct interests, (such as being a shareholder/director of a company or acting as a lecturer or consultant), or indirect interests, (the individual or co-workers receiving money, equipment or a salary which has been used to contribute to the running of research or clinical activities). In the absence of any such interests, members should make a written statement to that effect. A register of such interests will be held by the Committee Secretary.
